



## Certificate II in Fire Protection Inspection & Testing (CPP20511)

### COURSE OVERVIEW

This qualification applies to fire protection technicians responsible for non-trade installation and regular servicing of fire protection equipment and systems.

### HOW MUCH WILL IT COST?

To be eligible for a Certificate II in Fire Protection Inspection and Testing you will need to complete 7 core units at a cost of **\$1,065** and 6 elective units. The following elective units are available for selection with cost for each:

- CPPFES2037A—Inspect & test fire hydrant systems **(\$210)**
- CPPFES2039A—Identify, inspect & test passive fire & smoke containment products & system **(\$210)**
- CPPFES2035A—Identify, inspect & test fire and smoke doors **(\$210)**
- CPPFES2010A—Inspect & test fire hose reels **(\$210)**
- CPPFES2011A—Installation portable fire extinguishers & fire blankets **(\$210)**
- CPPFES2020A—Conduct routine inspection & testing of fire extinguishers & fire blankets **(\$210)**
- CPPFES2026A—Inspect & test emergency & exit lighting systems **(\$210)**
- CPPFES2003A—Safely move loads & dangerous goods **(\$210)**
- HLTFA301C—Apply First Aid (Credit Transfer only)
- CPPFES2016A—Inspect, test and maintain delivery lay flat fire hoses **(\$210)**
- CPPFES2029A—Conduct functional test on Fire Detection warning and intercommunication devices **(\$462)**
- CPPFES2047A- Inspect and test control and indicating equipment **(\$462)**
