

CPCPWT4022 Commission and Maintain Backflow Prevention Devices

This unit delivers and assesses participants skills and knowledge required to safely test, commission and maintain backflow prevention devices.

Participants are mostly existing plumbers seeking to gain a backflow prevention endorsement to their plumbing license. The program is suitable to newly qualified plumbers and completing apprentices however they will not meet QBCC licensing requirements.

Duration: 18.5 hours (over 2.5 days) face to face theoretical and practical training.

Delivery Mode: Face to face

Course Location: Programs are delivered from the Plumbing Industry Climate Action Centre, Glenwood Campus, NSW.

Pre-Requisites:

- CPCPCM2043 Carry out WHS requirements
- CPCPWT3027 Install backflow prevention devices

It is recommended that learners have acquired language, literacy and numeracy skills equivalent to Level 3 and Level 4 of the Australian Core Skills Framework (ACSF).
