NSW FAIR TRADING LICENSING

To become registered or licensed in performing Thermostatic Mixing Valve (TMV) Work, you must meet the requirements of NSW Fair Trading.

Their requirements are as follows:

- Be registered or licenced with NSW Fair Trading for Water Supply Work
- Hold the following two (2) prerequisite units:
 - o CPCPCM2043 Carry out WHS requirements
 - CPCPWT3022 Install and commission water heating systems and adjust controls and devices
